Cancer is a frightening diagnosis and it touches the lives of our families and friends each year. Since opening in 2007, the ARH Cancer Center in Hazard, Kentucky has made that diagnosis less devastating for those we serve.

In an average year, nearly 1,000 residents from an eight-county service area choose to have treatment at the ARH Cancer Center, a member of the renowned UK Markey Cancer Center Affiliate Network. Here they receive advanced medical and radiation oncology treatments, as well as infusion services, all in the same building. This enables our patients to be close to their support team of family and friends at a time when they need it most.

In the nine years since we opened our doors, our patient volume has grown steadily as has the number of cancer cases in our region. There is a desperate need to create additional space in our cancer center to accommodate patients' needs. EXPANDING OUR LEVEL OF CARE

Opened in 2007, the ARH Cancer Center is a 10,000 square foot, state-of-the-art cancer treatment facility that offers patients advanced cancer treatment close to home.

Sadly, we are battling a cancer epidemic like never before in eastern Kentucky. In our eight-county service area alone, there are around 1,800 new cancer cases diagnosed per year.

This ever-increasing patient volume requires additional space at the ARH Cancer Center to accommodate the growing number of patients needing cancer care.

Some highlights about the ARH Cancer Center

- Patients treated per year—1,000
- Hematologists/Oncologists on staff—3
- Radiation Oncologists on staff—1
- Chemotherapy treatments per year—3,000
- Radiation treatments per year—4,400
- Infusion treatments per year—2,000

The ARH Foundation and UK HealthCare are working together on a \$5 million capital campaign to expand the ARH Cancer Center to increase space, improve services, and provide even more opportunities to conquer cancer.

The new and renovated spaces will provide updated facilities customized to meet the specific medical needs of our patients and our community.

THE ARH CANCER CENTER EXPANSION PROJECT WILL ADD:

- 8,000 square feet of needed space
- A new vault for a linear accelerator
- Eight exam rooms
- Expanded patient/family waiting areas
- Five restrooms
- 21 chemotherapy chairs
- Three private chemotherapy rooms
